Over 700 Students have taken part in this Seminar.

In this Seminar the speaker delivered his views and the main aim of gender sensitization. It is to make people aware of the power relations between men and women in society and to understand the importance of affording women and men equally opportunities and treatment. Management-staff relations should be as non- vertical as possible: open, consultative, listening. Adequate resources should be devoted to putting such policies into practice. Gender equality should be a priority not only in the organization's mission statement, general objectives, and policies, but also in its internal regulations.

The organization should offer non-gender- stereotyped roles and choices for both men and women. This means not feminine management, but feminist management, understood as management (by both sexes) that is committed to women's empowerment. There should be greater parity in numbers and distribution of staff, more – importantly, women on the staff and especially in management must be committed to gender equality.

There should be scope for different organizational styles and cultures to coexist and be valued and for men and women together to explore and utilize difference without disempowering either side. Management should give unequivocal support to gender teams and staff members with specific responsibility for gender issues. Decision-making access for women should be built into the organization's structures, not dependent on informal agreements or arrangements, so that women's access to decision-making does not depend on the personalities and efforts of individuals.

Right of Equality

The Seminar was organized by Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology on “Right of Equality” was held in E-block seminar Hall on 19.12.2019. Mrs. SP Anchuri, Vice President, Indian Association of Structural Engineering, Hyderabad was invited as the chief Guest for this Seminar.

Speaker had explained the Need and Necessity of the Right of Equality in the Society. Right to Equality is an important fundamental right enshrined in the part 3 of the Indian Constitution. This is the founding principle of the other fundamental rights. The fundamental rights are provided to keep a check on the powers of executive as well as legislature. As per these rights all the person are equal and persons will be treated equally in similar circumstances. Article 14-18 covers the Right to Equality in the Indian Constitution.

The first and foremost one provided for by Article 14 is the right to equality before and equal protection of the laws. The right to equality as a concept has evolved from the Dicey's concept of the Rule of Law.

The concept of equality encompasses social and economic justice in a political democracy. The rights have been aimed at overturning the pre-independent evil social practices like untouchability, caste system. It abolishes the titles conferred on individuals on basis of caste, which had resulted in social evil like zamindari system, beggar. They also emphasize on the fundamental unity of India by guaranteeing to all citizens the access and use of the same facilities, irrespective of background. It also includes special treatment for the disadvantaged group for their social upliftment, to bring them at par with the general population.

Over 50 students were taking part in this discussion.

The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) a pandemic. A global coordinated effort is needed to stop the further spread of the virus. A pandemic is defined as “occurring over a wide geographic area and affecting an exceptionally high proportion of the population.” The last pandemic reported in the world was the H1N1 flu pandemic in 2009.

On 31 December 2019, a cluster of cases of pneumonia of unknown cause, in the city of Wuhan, Hubei province in China, was reported to the World Health Organization. In January 2020, a previously unknown new virus was identified, subsequently named the 2019 novel coronavirus, and samples obtained from cases and analysis of the virus’ genetics indicated that this was the cause of the outbreak. This novel coronavirus was named Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) by WHO in February 2020. The virus is referred to as SARS-CoV-2 and the associated disease is COVID-19.

As of 15 May 2020, over 4,444,670 cases have been identified globally in 188 countries with a total of over 302,493 fatalities. Also 1,588,858 were recovered Live data can be accessed here.
