- NSS activities are partially financed by the affiliating University. **E. Giri Prasad Goud** is the Coordinator. The college has provided a separate office and other facilities are created to run this program.
- This unit organizes Medical Camps, awareness of nutrition issues among the villagers, environmental protection, and education awareness programme among rural population.
- The institute has UBA center and received Rs. 50,000/- funding from MHRD. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a flagship national program of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India and IIT Delhi to develop villages in the vicinity of Institution. Under this we have adopted 5 villages Aziz Nagar, Bakaram, Himayat Nagar, Yenkapalle, & Chilkoor Village under Moinabad Mandal.
- Every year NSS team organizes one week special camp to the near by villages of the Institute.
- NSS 5th special camp was organized during 29th March 2019 to 4th April 2019 at Reddypally Village, Moinabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy, Telangana. The camp involved 45 NSS volunteers. The village is about 10 km away from VJIT and having a population of 1000.

- The main purpose was to maintain proper health in the faculty.

- Conducting this camp also aims at providing free tests for diabetes, blood pressure, haemoglobin etc.
- Also provides counseling for faculty by trained doctors and specialists.
- A team of 10 Doctors had attended.
- Around 250+ teaching and non-teaching faculty had attended.

Summary:

A health camp for Teaching and Non-Teaching faculty was organized on 25th Jan 2020 at VJIT Campus. Camp was organized in association with VJIT NSS and HDFC ERGO Health Insurance Co.Ltd.

A team of 10 Doctors from Apollo Hospital conducted the camp which included General physical examination along with Blood Sugar, Blood Pressure, Dental Check-up, Eye Check-up and ECG test.

Approximately 250 Teaching and Non-Teaching faculty from all the branches of VJIT Institution have attended. Necessary medical advice and precautionary measures were given to the faculty.

Camp was coordinated by Mr.E.GiriPrasad Goud, NSS coordinator.

A Free medical Camp can be considered as a life-saving program that aims to provide free medical and surgical services to poor communities living in rural or urban areas by a mobile team with varieties of medical specialized services.

So, medical camps provide free medical advice, medicine to the unfortunate people and refer for specialized treatment or surgery whenever it is required. These camps make sure people are getting healthcare at the right time, and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns serious.

Some NGOs, Charitable Medical Trusts, and medical professionals are driven by strong ethics of medicine who believe that it is the moral responsibility and obligation to treat each patient regardless of their income, race or social status. 





Under the guidance of JNTUH NSS Unit, VJIT-NSS Unit organized the Special Camp from 29th March to 4th April 2019 at ReddyPally Village, Moinabad Mandal, RR district involving 40 NSS volunteers. Prior to the camp permission from the Sarpanch was taken for organizing the camp at the ReddyPally village. The village is about 10 km away from VJIT and having a population of 1000. Based on the need of the village, the Sarpanch requested us for a Dental Camp and a Library for the school kids. Keeping in mind these two requests we have started our camp on 29th March 2019.



Day 1: Friday 29th March 2019:

All the volunteers gathered at college by 9.30 am and we started to the village around 10.00 am. The students were filled with lots of excitement and joy. We had to purchase the food items for the camp and reached the camp site by 11.00 am. With the help of the locals and Sarpanch, we started our day with the ZPHS Reddypally govt. school. The school consisted of 120 Students from Class I to Class X. With the permission from Mr.Anantha Reddy garu – Headmastre. we organized Inauguration, our first event on Skill Development and Interactive session. Before we could do that, the programme officer instructed the volunteers on the role that they have to play. What are the Do's and Don'ts that needs to be taken care. Volunteers were segregated into five batches based on Class I-IV, Class V & VII, Class VIII & IX. Each group was given the task of teaching the kids singing, dancing, and game. Basic English on personal introduction, Basic Maths, Computer Parts and most important how to be self confident. To our surprise the kids outstandingly received us well and in return we learned a lot from the kids.





We had our lunch prepared by NSS volunteers at 3.00 pm and took rest for a while. Then by 6.00pm we had a meeting to discuss on our next day event. We decided to have household survey and a door to door awareness program on the importance of health. We also informed the villagers about the Dental camp to be organized on 2nd April 2019 from 10.00 am

Later we had a review meeting around 9.00pm about the event that we organized on Day I.

Day II: Saturday 30th March 2019

The day started off at 6.00 am with a Yoga session, Exercises and sports for about 2 hours. As per the schedule we decided to organize the household survey. We have went to every house and collected all the information and suggested them solutions for few problems and motivated and at the end of the day we had cultural programs and also a review meeting on the feedback of the day event.







Day III: Sunday 31th March 2019:

The day started at 6.00 am with yoga, exercise and sports for two hours. Today also we continued with Household survey till 1:30pm. The common problems we found in Reddypally Village is scarcity of water, there is no drainage system and they requested for proper roads, private school and a hospital. In Reddypally village most of them are farmers and hardworking people. They are striving hard for the education of their children. We have motivated them to grow the plants and keep the surroundings clean. Took the survey forms on Digital Transaction and visited 160 houses and gathered information on how Reddypally Village is Digitalized village



Day IV: Monday 1st April 2019

The day started as usual at 6.00 pm with Yoga, Sports and exercises. After that we had our breakfast and started to the school where we organized Swachh Bharat in the entire village.











Using placards with various quotations on saving environment, no to plastic, planting and protecting trees and the importance of providing basic education to the kids we created awareness. Along with this we did

door to door awareness on the need to segregate wet and dry waste. We asked them to use the wet waste for agriculture and the dry waste to put it in a pit and later covering it with soil. So all the volunteers divided the work among themselves took part in the Swachh Bharath. During the cleaning the major waste that we could see was that of plastic and diapers. We segregated the biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste. 




Later at around 2 pm we reached camp base, had our lunch and discussed about the evening session on Digital Transaction.




5th SPECIAL CAMP
