- Breast Cancer
- Lip, Oral cavity
- Cervix uteri
- Lung
- Colorectum

Preventive Measures:

- Be smoke free
- Drink less alcohol
- Eat a high fibre diet
- Keep a healthy weight
- Avoid unnecessary radiation (including radon gas and x-rays)
- Be safe in the sun
- Cut down on processed meat
- Avoid certain substances at work (such as asbestos)
- Avoid air pollution
- Protect against certain infections (such as HPV and H. Pylori)
- Breastfeed if possible
- Be more active
- Minimize HRT use

Basic Facts About Skin Cancer

Melanoma
 Accounts for about 4% of skin cancer cases, but causes about 79% of skin cancer deaths.
 The number of new cases of melanoma is on the rise.

Non-melanoma (basal cell or squamous cell)
 Most common type of skin cancer – more than 1 million cases a year
 Most curable
 People do not often die of these cancers. Men get these cancers about twice as often as women.

Basic Facts About Prostate Cancer

Prostate cancer is the second leading cause of death in men, second only to lung cancer.

While 1 man in 6 will get prostate cancer during his lifetime, 1 man in 33 will die of this disease.

65% of prostate cancer cases are diagnosed in men 65 and older.

African American men are at higher risk.

Prostate cancer is the most frequently diagnosed cancer in men.



Prostate Cancer Screening Guidelines


Beginning at age 50, men should be offered the Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) blood test and a digital rectal examination (DRE) every year.

African American men are at increased risk for prostate cancer and should be tested beginning at age 45.

Men with a father, brother, or son with prostate cancer before age 65 should be tested.

The 5-year survival rate for men diagnosed at a local or regional stage approaches 100%.

Cervical Cancer Screening Guidelines

Screening should begin 3 years after a woman becomes sexually active, but no later than 21 years of age.

The American Cancer Society recommends screening with the regular Pap test every year or the liquid-based Pap test every 2 years.

Nearly all cases of cervical cancer can be prevented if a woman is screened regularly.

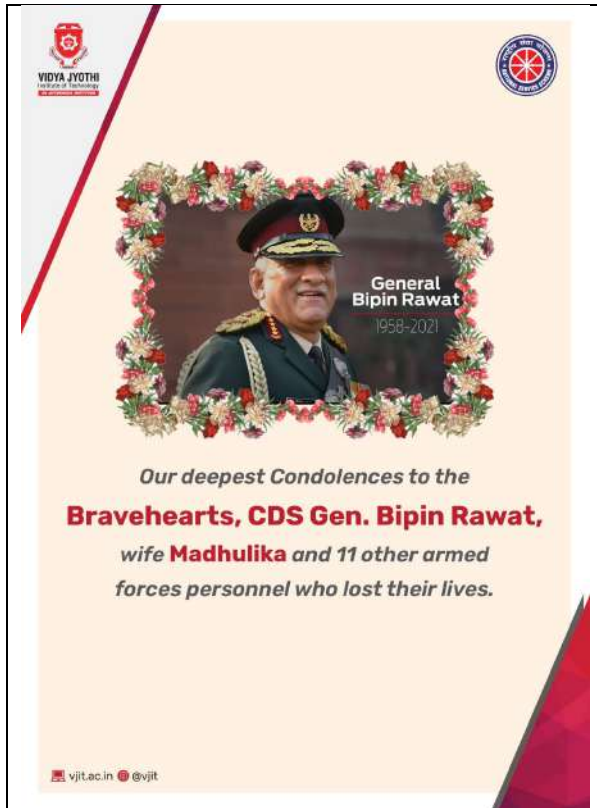

The College provided all the required facilities like space, furniture, Blood group testing rooms, blood donating room with good hygiene and sanitation as per the medical standard along with 45 NSS Student and Faculty volunteers. The camp was inaugurated by Dr E. 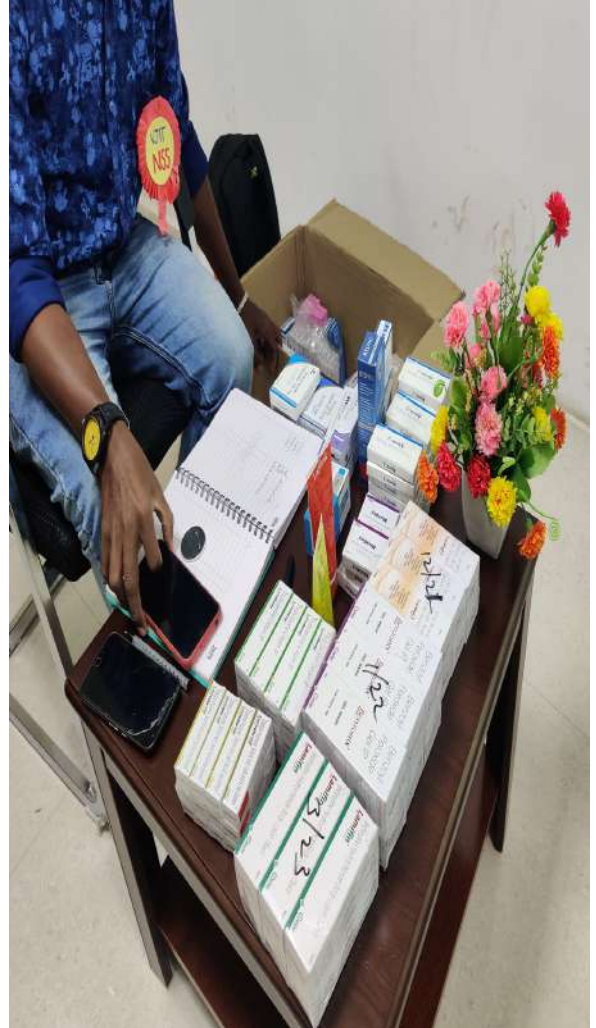

Dr Raghu Ram has disseminated a wealth of information about breast cancer through the webinar. The information given on Awareness surrounding breast cancer has been incredibly important as early detection is possible and treatment can catalyze recovery.

He said the average risk of a woman developing breast cancer sometime in her life is about 12%, or a 1 in 8 chance. The main risk factors for breast cancer include being a woman and getting older and the most breast cancers are found in women ages 55 and older. Uncontrollable factors that may increase risk include personal/family history, race, breast density and menstrual period history.

Some Signs and Symptoms of Breast Cancer

Every woman should know how her breasts normally look and feel, so she can recognize any changes that may occur. While knowing what to look for is important, a woman should still get her regular mammograms and clinical breast exams, as these tests can help detect breast cancer before she even has symptoms,” said Dr Raghu Ram.

Signs of breast cancer may include:

Lump in the breast or underarm (armpit)

Swelling or thickening of all or part of the breast

Dimpling or skin irritation of breast skin

Localized, persistent breast pain

Redness, scaliness or thickening of the nipple or breast skin

Nipple discharge (other than breast milk)

Any change in the size or shape of the breast

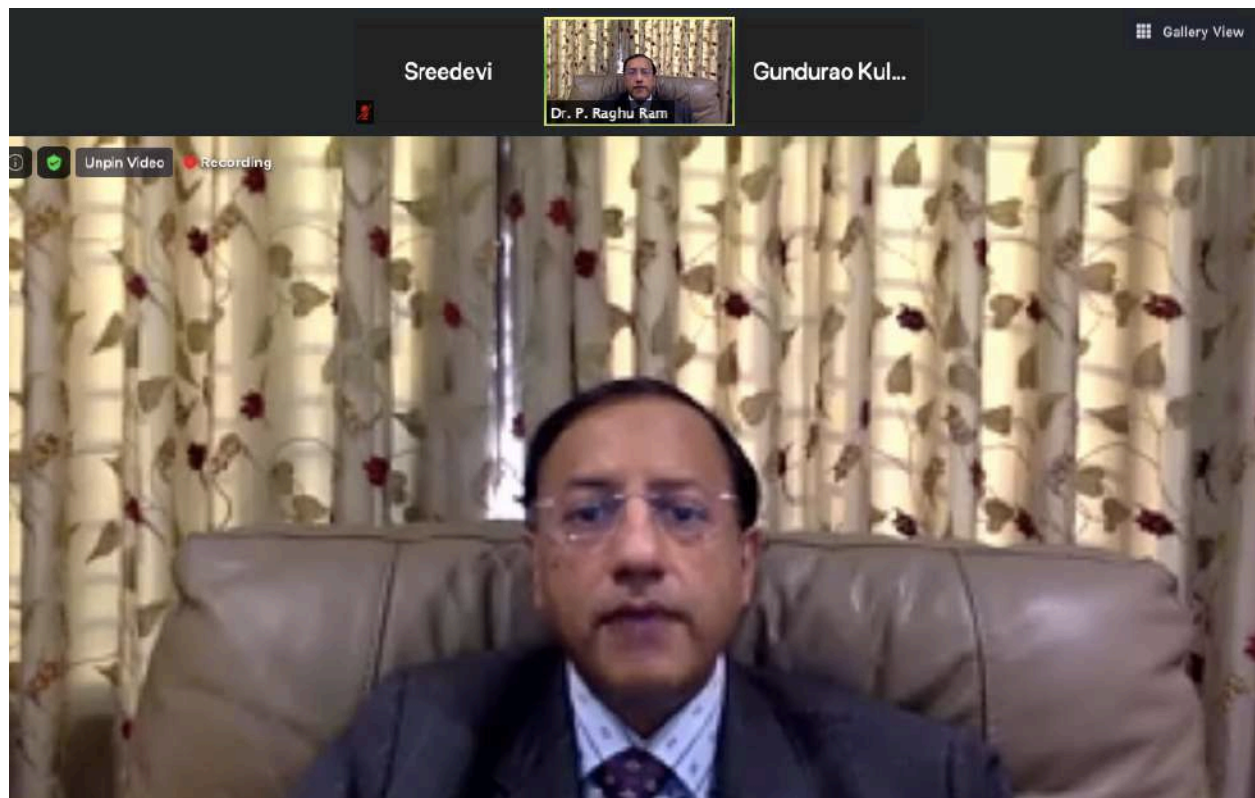
To lower risk of breast cancer:

Get to and stay at a healthy weight. Balance your food intake with physical activity to avoid excess weight gain.

Be physically active. Every week, get at least 150 minutes of moderate intensity or 75 minutes of vigorous intensity activity (or a combination of these).

Limit or avoid alcohol.

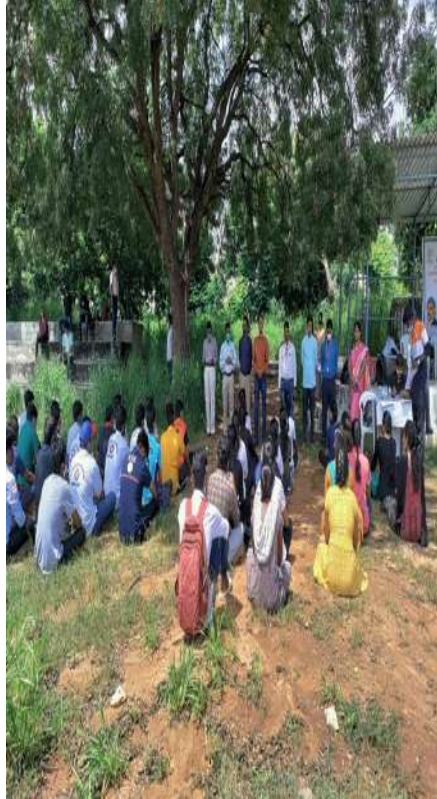

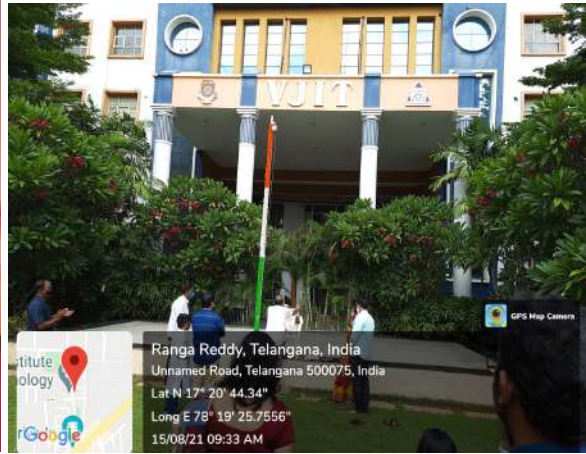

- b) Take frequent breaks from ANY sustained posture every 20-30 minutes

Modify Tasks:

- a) Alternate activities frequently, rotate heavy &/or repetitive tasks with lighter less repetitive ones.
- b) If symptoms become worse REASSESS task setup & look for alternative methods
- c) Avoid repetitive or prolonged grip activities
- d) Avoid pinching with wrist in flexion or wrist deviation (bending to side)
- e) Take frequent breaks to stretch & rest hands
