Ramanaiah, Professor, Dept. of CSE and Dr. M.V.S.S. Giridhar, Professor, Dept. of CEA & WMT to the Academic Council and thanked all the members for joining the meeting.

He thanked the outgoing members Dr. Asha Rani, Prof, Dept. of ECE & Dr. Tara Kalyani Prof, Dept. of EEE for their valuable inputs and timely suggestions, during their tenure as Nominees of JNTUH.

He appraised the Members that he is glad to share that the Institution stands in the Rank band of 201-300 in NIRF Ranking 2024.

With the permission of the members the Chairman presented the following items on agenda for discussion:

Item No. 1: The Action taken report of the 23rd & 24th Academic Council meetings held on 10th June 2023 (Off-line) and 18th January 2024 (through Circulation Mode)

Chairman appraised the Members regarding the Action taken report on the Minutes of 23rd & 24th Academic Council meetings. The following implementations were noted and ratified:

- The new course structures and syllabi of B. Tech II year are followed from the A.Y. 2023-24
- R23 Academic Regulations, Course structure and Syllabus of M. Tech are followed as per JNTUH R22 Regulations from the A.Y. 2023-2024 in toto.
- The relaxation in the promotion rules as per the JNTUH proceedings No.A1/16/2023 dated 23rd December, 2023 for students of certain regulations of B.Tech. are being implemented.
- Grace Marks as per JNTUH proceedings vide. JNTUH/EB/R18 Grace Marks/2/2023 dated 14th December 2023 for students admitted under R18 and R19 Regulation are adopted.



Item No. 2: To ratify the Minutes of Boards of Studies meetings of all the Departments for B. Tech 3rd year and 4th year of all the U.G. Programs under R22 Regulations

Principal has presented the Course structures and Syllabi of B. Tech III and IV years approved by respective Boards of Studies of all the Departments to be adopted for students admitted under R22 Regulations along with the Minutes of BoS meetings before the Council for ratification.

Dr M.V. Krishna Murthy, Member and Dr. Balaji Utla, Member suggested to include Laboratory Courses to support the Theory courses such as Devops, Linux Programming and Web Technologies. Dr. MVS Giridhar, JNTUH Nominee opined that few Courses may be offered beyond the Curriculum as Non Credit Courses. Prof. O.B.V. Ramanaiah, JNTUH Nominee further added that students may be encouraged to register for Courses under MOOCS.

Principal placed the Course structures, Syllabus and BoS Minutes of the Department of MBA to be followed from A.Y. 2024-2025 and also the Courses offered to B. Tech Programs before the Academic Council for approval.
